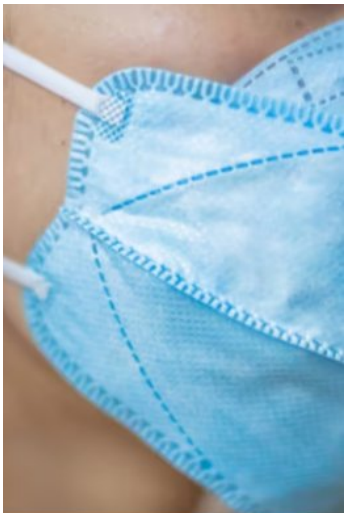


Elections BC Investigates Voting Irregularities Following Narrow NDP Victory
