Employment Growth Slows Despite Gains

B.C. added 23,400 jobs in January, with both full-time and part-time employment increasing. However, employment growth has slowed since mid-2024, and the unemployment rate edged up to 6% as labour force growth outpaced job gains. Construction and manufacturing saw strong gains, while agriculture and utilities declined.


