Through this program, which will be available starting June 15, employers can apply to be reimbursed for up to three days of wages paid to workers for COVID-19-related sick leave.

How to apply:

In order to apply for the B.C. government's COVID-19 Sick-Leave Reimbursement Program, employers must:

- Be registered for WorkSafeBC insurance coverage
- Have signed up for WorkSafeBC's online services
- Not have an existing paid sick-leave program

The program application will be available on WorkSafeBC's online-services portal starting June 15. Visit worksafebc.com to learn more.

In addition to hosting the sick-leave reimbursement application, WorkSafeBC's online-services portal for employers provides functionality to report payroll, pay premiums, and access additional tools.
