  - Take part in the relevant tele-town hall or virtual event.
- 2) Write a letter to Premier John Horgan at [premier@gov.bc.ca](mailto:premier@gov.bc.ca) and copy it to your local MLA. You can find your local MLA and their email at <https://www.leg.bc.ca/learn-about-us/members>
- 3) Encourage your employees to do #1 and #2. Employee feedback is very important.
- 4) Speak to your local suppliers and ask them to make a similar submission.

We recommend you consider the following in your submission:

- what are the much needed infrastructure projects in your communities and why it should be a priority.
- How your business and its employees would benefit from infrastructure projects in your community.
- The size and diversity of your workforce.
- The benefit to the local suppliers you use.
- The Benefit to the community, both in near-term economic stimulus and long-term benefit of the infrastructure.
