Subject: B.C. launches restart plan to safely bring people back together

In important news today, the province of B.C. has announced a plan to lift restrictions. The four stages of reopening are highly dependent on the assumption that there isn't another crisis or wave of COVID-19. This will be largely dependent on how people respond to the re-opening and how closely they adhere to the PHO safety protocols and directives.

Key highlights include:

- As of today (May 25) indoor personal gatherings of up to 5 people are allowed. Still can't travel outside of our travel region (travel restrictions are still in place).
- June 15 at the earliest, travel restrictions within BC may be lifted.
- July 1 at the earliest, the province hopes to lift the public health emergency allowing a return to "usual" indoor and outdoor activities.
- September 7 at the earliest, normal social contact is expected with no limits on gatherings and businesses can resume "normalcy".
- The province expects schools to return to "normal" in the fall with appropriate safety measures in place (TBD).
